Lent Lunches: A soup lunch will be served every Monday in Lent from 12 noon until 2pm in the Cathedral Lodge. Proceeds will go to support the work of Porchlight.

Looking Towards the Cross: Bible study groups will meet in the Cathedral Lodge at 7.30pm on Tuesdays between 12 March and 9 April to explore Scriptures that help us to reflect upon the mystery of the Cross, followed by a short time of worship.

Holy Week Talks: From Monday to Wednesday at 1pm in the Cathedral Lodge there will be devotional talks focussing on the way Jesus used the basic gifts of the natural environment. A sandwich lunch will be served from 12.45pm.

Sacred Space: During Lent *Sacred Space* will explore the theme of **Water in the Wilderness**. We meet at 7pm on Wednesdays (on Ash Wednesday we join the 6.30pm Holy Communion) for a time of song, discussion, and meditation in the Crypt followed by food. All students and young adults welcome.

The Saviour of the World: Walking with Jesus on the Way of the Cross. On Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday of Holy Week at 7.30pm the Archbishop will give a series of devotional talks based on the Stations of the Cross illustrated by artwork, photographs of contemporary events, and music.

From Monday to Thursday of Holy Week at 6.15pm a two course hot meal will be available in the Cathedral Lodge Refectory prior to these events. Places must be booked in advance (£12.95 per night or £50 for all four nights). There will be reserved seating in the Cathedral for those eating at the Lodge.
